HEALTH RESEARCHER FOR A DAY • GRADES 7 AND 8

HALF DAY (2.5 hours)

- \$4 per student

Through perseverance, determination, teamwork and innovative thinking, Canada's medical heroes have profoundly impacted the development of health in Canada and the world. Students learn about the inspiring accomplishments of the Laureates of CMHF and explore the concepts of scientific inquiry while understanding cells, as the basis of life, with a DNA extraction experiment.



FULL DAY (5 hours)

- \$8 per student

This option also includes exploration of **Banting House National Historic Site** (442 Adelaide Street North, walking distance to CMHF). Students learn about the life, career and art of CMHF Laureate Sir Frederick Banting including his contribution to the discovery of insulin. Students explore reconstructions of Dr. Banting's office and bedroom, and various types of equipment he may have used during his time living in London and as a doctor during World War I.
